I did a ride-a-long in January. It was good to be out in the field again. We saw one incident that showed what happens when drive when your brain is on illegal drugs.

I also took one day to be in the jail. I learned the process for handing out bibles and meeting inmate requests for one-on-one sessions with a chaplain. I was able to be in seven one-on-one sessions dealing with grief, relationship, and dietary issues.

We had a good chaplain's meeting in January. Many things are in process that will make how we function in the field easier. Many of these are related to communication. Call signs, radios, pagers, county call out coverage for all police and fire, and SOP's for all chaplain's. These require some additional training from fire chaplains to police chaplains and vice versa. I have feeling that fire may have more to learn because of the evidence thing at crime scenes.

I have resumed a full teaching schedule with the singles ministries at Beaverton Christian Church and Westside Singles Ministries.
