Dear Friends,

It has been exciting to see how God has prepared me and answered prayer for a new ministry. My training and experience as a law enforcement chaplain opened doors for me to accept the call to serve as a Community Chaplain with the Washington County Sheriff's Office.

My primary focus will be the community. At incidents my ministry will be to family, victims, and other members of the community. I will answer calls from police, fire and ambulance throughout Washington County. This is a new position for a chaplain and I will be creating the role as we go. I will have contact with deputies as they call as well as focus on dispatch personnel. I also will answer calls for a chaplain from inmates on a limited basis.

I am called to situations involving death and other crises. These include suicides, car accidents, homicides, natural disasters, domestic violence, fires, medical emergencies and whenever a deputy thinks I would be of assistance. I will also be involved in providing Critical Incident Stress Management services to the public and emergency personnel.

I am asking you to join me in this ministry in two ways. The first way is prayer support as I serve in this important ministry. The second way is monetary support. I need to raise my financial support. Any amount, any time is appreciated, and would you consider donating every month?
